Leadership Nominations

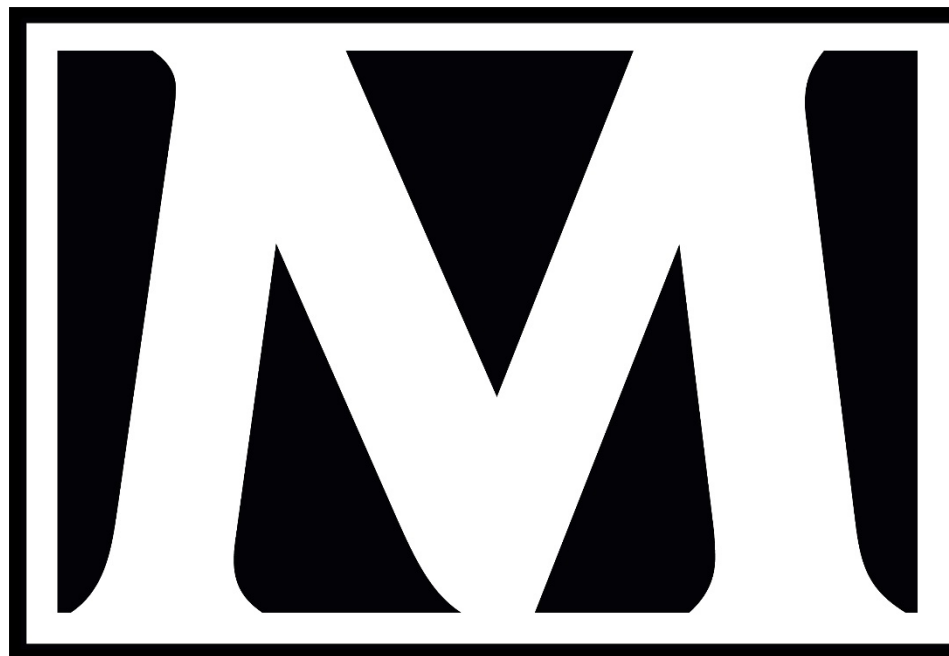
Leadership nominations for Ruling Elder and Deacon have begun. Leadership nomination form can be given to an elder or during our time of offering
