Big Idea: While the enemy throws wave after wave of attacks, God's Word cannot be stopped in spreading the kingdom of God to the ends of the earth.

2nd Sunday Lunch Brunch – Youth Sunday

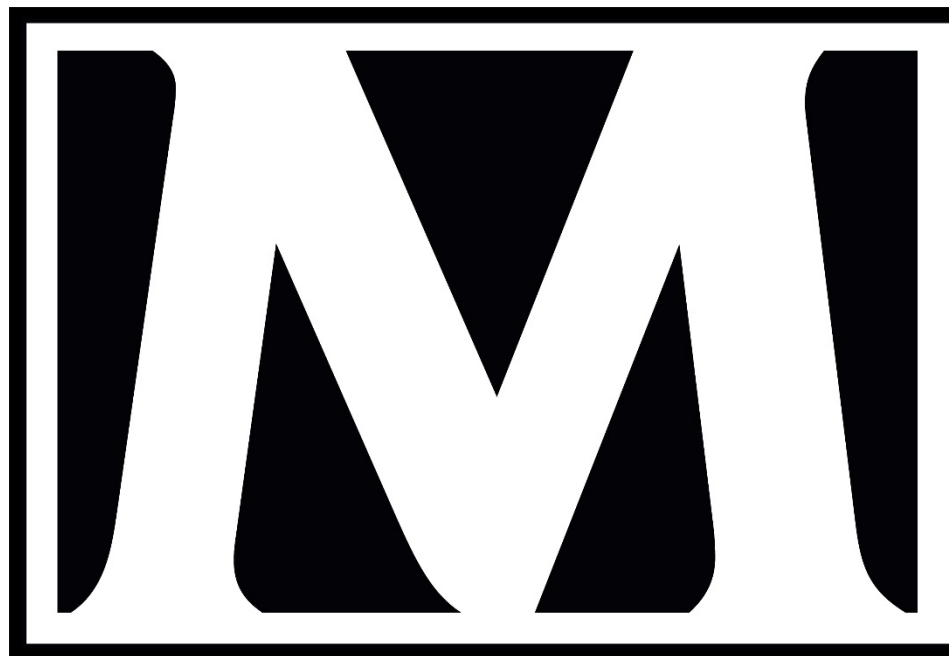
