VBS Work Day Update

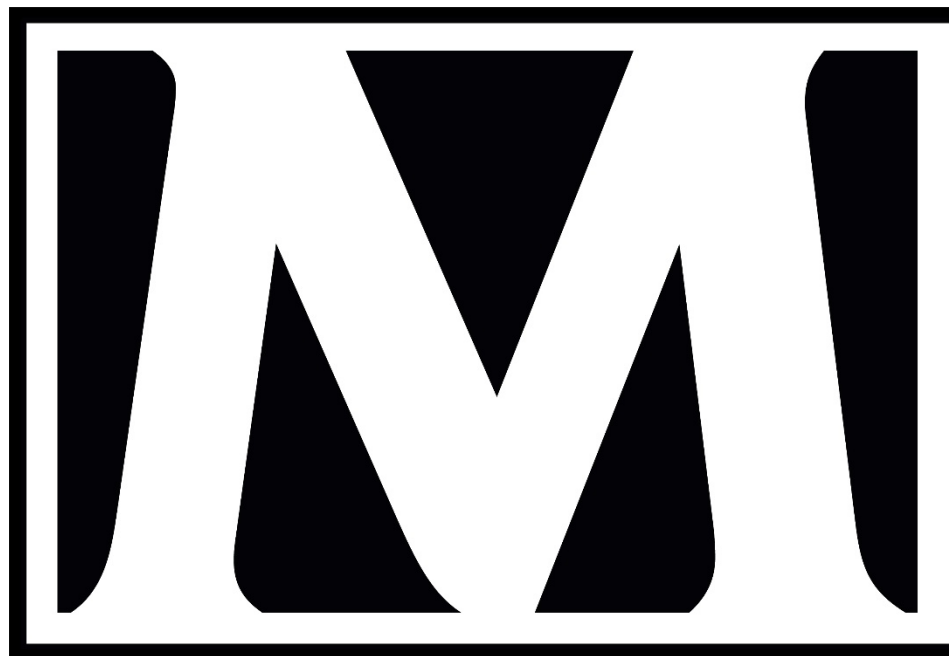
We have finalized the time for our VBS workday on 7 June. It will be held from 9:00am-12:00pm to make decorations and other preparations for Upward Bound.
