### **New Psalm to Sing**

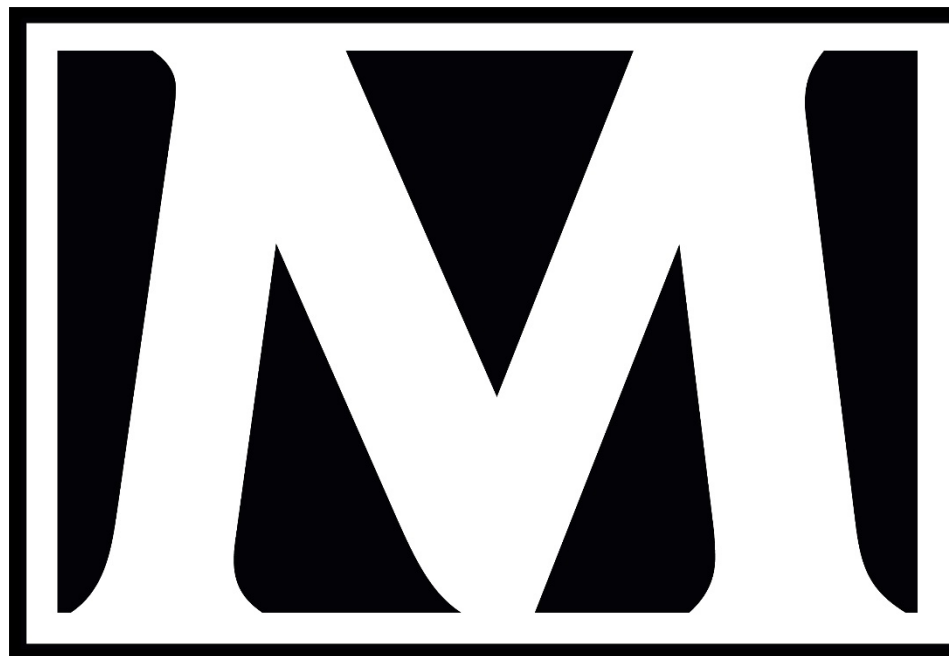
