Elder/Deacon Nominations

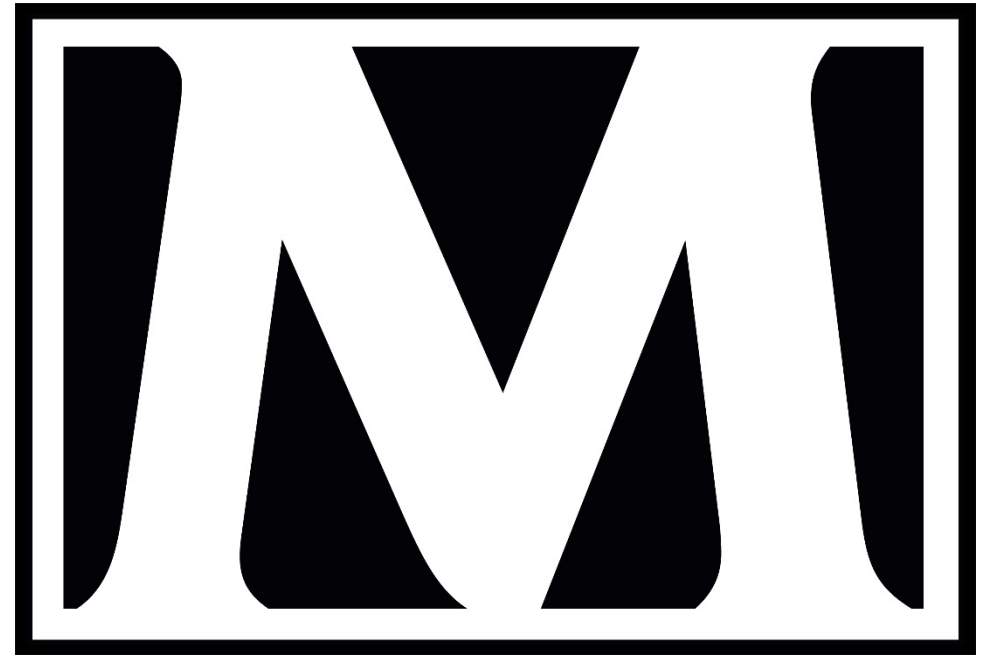
