Women's Book Studies

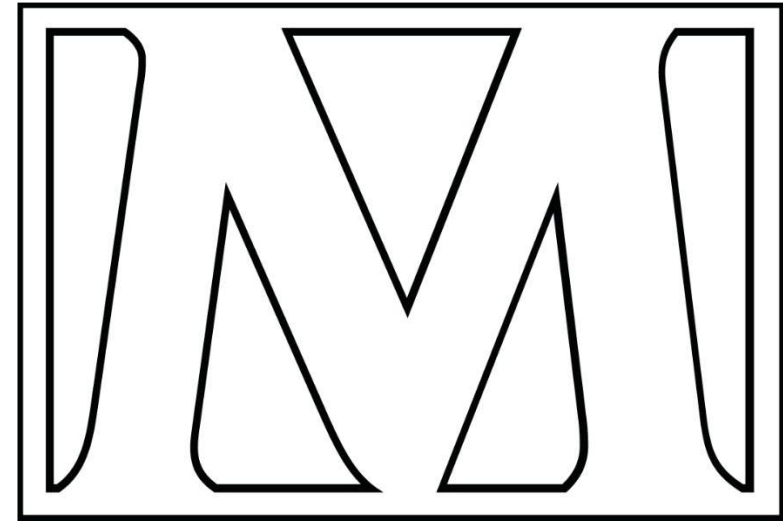
