Church BBQ at Hope Manor

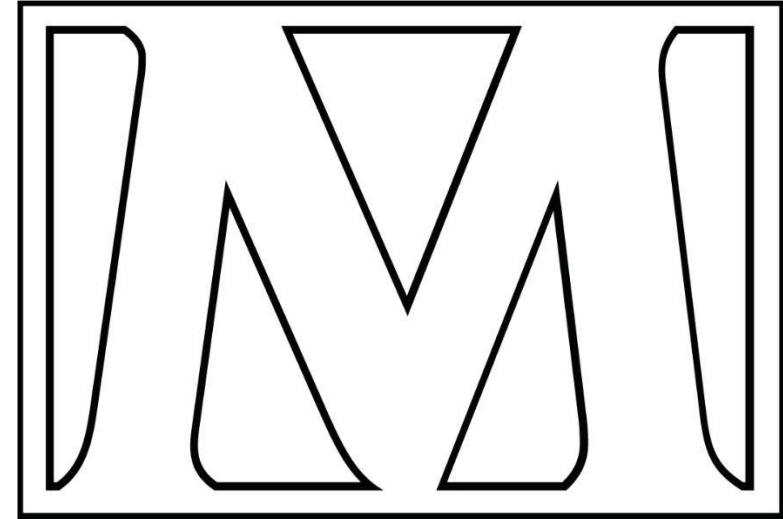
